THE SERIES
 » The 2018 Makers Wanted Bahamas Bowl will be the fourth meeting between the FIU Panthers and the Toledo Rockets, and the first between the schools since the 2010 Little Caesars Pizza Bowl in Detroit, where FIU won 34-32 in the Panthers' first bowl appearance. FIU leads the all-time series, 2-1.

THE COACHES
 » **BUTCH DAVIS** is in his second season as FIU head coach (16-9 record) and his 12th season as a collegiate head coach (95-52 overall record). The 2018 Makers Wanted Bahamas Bowl is the Panthers second-straight bowl appearance and FIU's fourth bowl appearance overall. Davis served as head coach at Miami (Fla.) from 1995-2000 and North Carolina from 2007-10. He was the NFL's Cleveland Browns head coach (2001-04) and an assistant coach for the Dallas Cowboys (1989-94), where he was part of back-to-back Super Bowl-winning teams (XXVII and XXVIII). Davis also was a college assistant coach at Miami (1984-88), where he was part of the Hurricanes' 1987 National Championship team, and Oklahoma State (1979-83).

» **JASON CANDLE** is in his third full season as a collegiate head coach (all at Toledo), and he has a 28-12 career record. The 2018 Makers Wanted Bahamas Bowl is the Rockets' fifth-straight bowl appearance and Toledo's 11th bowl appearance overall. Candle was an assistant coach at Mount Union (2002-08) and Toledo (2009-15). He played wide receiver at Geneva College (1998-99) and Mount Union (2000-01).
